## House crime prevention

The University of Chester works closely with local partners to help keep you safe. Taking a few simple precautions can reduce the risk of you being targeted by criminals:

- Lock all outside windows and doors even when you are at home. 1 in 3 burglaries are a result of an open or unlocked door or window
- Don't leave your valuables on view and if you've got an alarm use it
- You can register any valuable property (e.g. laptops, mobile phones, tablets) on <u>www.immobilise.com</u> free of charge. This helps the police to return lost or stolen items to their rightful owners & can act as a deterrent to thieves.

## How to have fun responsibly

- Keep your windows and doors closed to stop noise from travelling
- Having a party? Ideally do it at a venue. If at home make sure you discuss this with your neighbours in advance, agree a time for it to finish and stick to it
- Make sure any speakers are not against the wall and turn the bass down
- Be careful about noise outside of the property. Don't forget you are responsible for your guests' behaviour
- If you are getting a taxi, ask the driver to call or text you when they arrive and not to beep its horn. Wait indoors until it arrives
- Keep the noise down in the early hours of the morning both on the street and in the house. Your neighbours might have to be up early
