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## What is Students as Recruiters?

## How does it work?

### Step 1: Apply

All students are invited to apply via this [link](#) by Monday 14th October 2024.

### Step 2: Attend a training session

If your application is successful, you will be invited to attend an essential training session on Wednesday 23rd October 2024.

### Step 3: Become a Student as Recruiter Representative

You will be notified throughout the year when recruitment is taking place and asked to participate when required. However, your participation is decided by you; and this flexible approach is what makes this scheme so great!

### Step 4: Getting the most out of being a Student as Recruiter

Throughout the role you:

- Will be supported to develop key employability skills
- Can consider putting your experience towards the Chester Difference Award as you develop many skills including communication, teamwork and leadership. Being a Student as Recruiter also counts as one activity towards the Preparing for Recruitment pathway.
